AN ORDINANCE AMENDING WATER USE ORDINANCES  
92-11B, 94-10A, 07-11A, 09-04A, 11-9C, 18-2, AND 24-6D  
IN ORDER TO ADJUST THE WATER USER FEES

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Maurice, Louisiana, that Ordinances 92-11B, 94-10A, 07-11A, 09-04A, 11-9C, 18-2, and 24-6D are hereby amended to reflect the following:

1. The monthly water user fees are hereby amended by this ordinance with the rates shown to be implemented and charged to the customers served by the Town of Maurice’s Water System based on the following:

USER	RATE
<b>a. Residential Customers</b>	
Flat Rate:	
For the First 2,000-Gallons or Part Thereof	\$ 21.00
Volumetric Charge:	
Per Thousand Gallons or Part Thereof	
Thereafter	\$ 6.85
<b>b. Commercial, Nursing Home/Assisted Living and Industrial Customers</b>	
Flat Rate:	
For the First 2,000-Gallons or Part Thereof	\$ 21.00
Volumetric Charge:	
Per Thousand Gallons or Part Thereof	
Thereafter	\$ 7.00
<b>c. Multifamily Housing Facilities:</b>	
Flat Rate:	
Per Apartment	\$ 21.00
Volumetric Charge:	
Per Thousand Gallons or Part Thereof	\$ 6.85

2. The minimum charge to all residential, commercial, and multifamily housing facilities customers, and the charge per 1,000 gallons of water usage to all customers, shall be increased annually by an amount equal to the percentage increase, if any, for the previous 12 months as determined by the Consumer Price Index for All Items issued by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, in January of each year. Said minimum charge and water usage charge shall be increased by the percentage computed and shall be reflected in the first billing period of January of each year,
3. The Town of Maurice Water System commits to fulfil its obligations under the Water Sector grant by establishing an Asset Reserve Fund. The Town of Maurice Water System shall deposit at least \$1,067.85 into the Asset Reserve Fund monthly for a period of 20 years to repair or rehabilitate the elevated water storage tank at the Town’s South Wastewater Treatment Facility.
